

Port handling of dangerous goods

Basic principles:

- Information
- Permitted stay of dangerous goods
- Segregation of incompatible Dangerous goods

Permitted stay on the quay, yard

– only allowed for changing transport mode

Two categories:

- Direct.
- 10 days.

Determination of the permitted stays

IMDG Class 1 and 7: Always direct.

IMDG Class 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 och 9: 10 days.

2 Gases (toxic, flammable, corrosive)

3 Flammable liquids (flash point $\leq 23^{\circ}\text{C}$ and $\geq 23^{\circ}\text{C}$)

4.1 Flammable solids

4.2 Spontaneously Combustible Solids

4.3 Dangerous when Wet (water)

5.1 Oxidizing Agent

5.2 Organic Peroxide Oxidizing Agent

Note:

The handling of dangerous goods, new goods flows or products that can cause harm to humans and the environment is assessed on an ongoing basis. This may give rise to special conditions.

Classes with special conditions

Ammonium Nitrate

- Possible fire guard needed.
- Special requirements for separation, nothing combustible nearby or other heat-affected.
