

## Emergency Energy Surcharge

Dear Valued Customer,

It is unfortunate, but in these unprecedented times it is no longer possible to sustain our handling rates without adding a surcharge as operational costs have increased dramatically, and current rates were offered when costs were at a lower level. This surcharge is added to relieve some of these additional costs.

For a long time, The Port of Helsingborg have absorbed the expense of increased energy costs, but current circumstances with record high prices on energy have forced us to make the decision to add a surcharge of SEK 40.00 to each handled unit. The surcharge will be applicable for all import and export units, both laden and empty, that are loaded or discharged to/from vessel at Port of Helsingborg.

The energy surcharge is implemented as a measure to secure our level of service and to maintain an efficient and satisfying operation.

The energy surcharge per handled unit is subject to change and will be re-assessed quarterly. Depending on energy price fluctuations the surcharge will be amended accordingly.

The Emergency Energy Surcharge will come into effect January 1, 2023 until further notice and will as stated above be re-evaluated quarterly.

The Port of Helsingborg will charge you the energy surcharge as a separate line-item on your invoice.

We thank you for your understanding and support and look forward continuing serving you and your logistic requirements.
